Multi-Student Discount: The multi-student family discount is based upon the number of children attending in grades 1st through 12th grades. Preschool and Kindergarten students are not included when determining the family discount.

Catholic Student Discount: Butte's local Catholic parishes generously support our Schools each year. Practicing Catholics, who are members of a local Catholic parish are eligible for a parish discount per child. Families are required to provide a parish discount form from their parish confirming eligibility. Local parishes include: Holy Spirit, St. Ann, Butte Catholic Community North (St. Patrick's & Immaculate Conception) and Butte Catholic Community Central (St. John the Evangelist and St. Joseph's.)

Scholarships / Financial Assistance: Butte Central Catholic Schools and the Butte Central Education Foundation proudly awards nearly \$500,000 in Scholarships / Financial Assistance every year. In order to be considered for possible financial assistance and/or guardian angel scholarships, families are required to complete a FACTS Grant and Aid application. Low income families may also apply for the ACE Scholarship through the ACE Foundation. An ACE scholarship will provide an annual scholarship of \$2,000 towards a grade school student tuition assessment or \$3,000 toward a high school student tuition assessment.
